Reminders

- Put carts out the night before pickup in a visible spot at the end of driveways.
- All trash must be contained within the cart.
- Pull in carts by 10 am the day after collection.
- No plastic bags or materials contaminated by food, grease, etc. in recycling, including pizza boxes, regular trash, tents, beach chairs or other furniture.
- All materials left outside the cart will not be picked up. If you frequently run out of room, another cart should be ordered.
- Construction/renovation debris will not be picked up and must be brought to an Onslow County Convenience Center.
- The new GFL recycling carts are neon green with a dark lid. Older recycling carts are blue. The new GFL trash carts are brown with a neon green lid. Older trash carts may be dark green, solid brown or gray.
- *** New carts will be delivered under our new contract in November 2025 ***

2025 Vegetation Debris Schedule:

Place vegetative debris out on or one week before:

- February 16, 2025
- April 20, 2025
- October 19, 2025

Vegetation pick-up will be provided as a one-time only sweep immediately after the dates above. All vegetation must be placed roadside on or one week before the dates above. Debris not placed out on or one week before the dates above will not be collected.

Bulk Pick-up

GFL will offer bulk item pickup twice per year in the fall and spring. Dates will be announced soon.

- **Bulk Item Pick-up includes:**
 - Household Furniture
 - Cardboard
 - Lawn Furniture
 - Toys
 - Mattresses and/or Bedding

Instructions for Homeowners:

- Please place vegetation near the roadside in the right-of-way on or one week before the dates above.
- Debris must be placed in right-of-way – the Town does not go on private property to pick-up debris.
- Public Works will be providing the pick-up as a one time only sweep immediately after the dates above.
- Grass clippings, mulch, leaves, pine straw, vines and any other small plant/shrub/tree clippings must be in paper lawn and leaf bags. These bags are available at local hardware and grocery stores. Acceptable material placed in plastic or any other type of bags besides paper will not be picked up.
- Tree limbs must be no longer than 6 feet in length and no larger than 6 inches in diameter. All vegetation must be placed in the right-of-way for pick up and should not be placed in or obstruct a roadway in any way.
- Debris from lot clearing (l.e. building a home) is not included and will not be picked up. Vegetative debris resulting from the hiring of any private contractor will not be picked up and is the responsibility of the contractor - the Town will not remove.
