Additional collection on **Saturday** seasonally\*

\*Seasonal Collection May 1st to October 31st



Recycling  
Every **Wednesday** only

## FEES

- Effective July 2022, the fee is \$18.85 per month (\$226.20 per year).
  - This includes one solid waste cart, one recycling cart, and year-round pick-ups.
  - Billed on ONWASA customer's water bills.
- If a cart is lost, it is \$80 to replace.
- No seasonal bin rentals.
- There is a fine of \$50.00 per day for leaving trash carts by the road after 10 a.m. the day after collection

## TRASH

- The Town no longer does bulk pick up and no longer accepts these items at Public Works.
- The following items will NOT be collected:
  - Construction or demolition debris
  - Yard debris
  - Liquids or sharp items
  - Dirt, rock, or concrete
  - Hot ashes
  - Wet paint (paint cans must dry out completely)
  - Hazardous materials, chemicals, or pesticides
  - Flammables
  - Tires
- The Town no longer has dumpsters at Public Works available for use by property owners. The alternative site is located at the nearby Folkstone Trash & Recycle Convenience Center at 320 Old Folkstone Road, Sneads Ferry, NC 28445

## RECYCLING

- No materials contaminated with food, grease, etc.
- No plastic bags of any kind.
- No disposable coffee cups or cutlery, greasy pizza boxes or Styrofoam.
- When in doubt, throw it out!
- Accepted items:
  - Plastic with the numbers 1-7 Bottles • Containers • Jugs • Tin • Aluminum • Steel • Empty aerosol cans • Corrugated cardboard (flattened) • Cereal and dry food boxes • Tissue boxes • Cartons • Paper • Newspapers • Inserts • Labels • Magazines • Envelopes • Glass • Jars • Bottles
- Non-accepted items:
  - Plastic bags • Shredded or small scraps of paper • Styrofoam • Trash • Receipts • Hardcover books • Disposable cups and cutlery • Clothing or fabric • Light bulbs • Electronics • Hazardous waste • Tires • Dishes or cookware • Tanglers (Garden hoses, cords, wire, etc.) • Window or mirror glass • Liquid waste • Medical waste • Construction or yard debris • Batteries • Toys • Diapers • Scrap wood • Beach equipment (chairs, umbrellas, toys, etc.) • Plastic pumps • Scrap metal

## VEGETATION

- 3 times a year (February, April, November)
- All grass clippings, mulch, leaves, straw and vines must be in paper lawn and leaf bags (available at local hardware stores). Plastic bags will not be picked up.
- Tree limbs must be no longer than 6 feet in length and no larger than 6 inches in diameter.
- Debris from lot clearing (ex. to build a home) will not be picked up. Vegetative debris resulting from the hiring of a private contractor is the responsibility of the contractor. It will not be removed by Town Staff.

## REMINDERS

- All bins must be placed in a visible spot at the end of driveway.
- Place all trash and recycling in bin — bags on the curb won't be picked up.
- Pull in all bins by 10 a.m. the day after collection. Violations punishable by fine.
- Place carts curbside no earlier than noon the day before trash pickup. Collection will begin at 6:00 a.m.
